

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding is made and entered at Amaltas Institute of medical sciences, Dewas this day of 1 nov 2018 to 31 oct 2019 for clinical training and Academics .

### BETWEEN

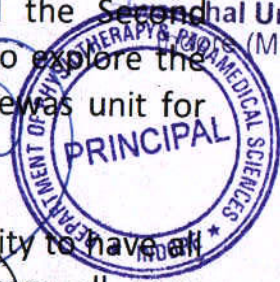
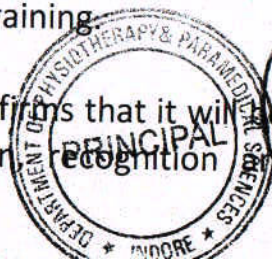

### AND

Amaltas Institute of medical sciences, Dewas, registered under the "Mayank Welfare Society, Indore" of the Second Part.

### WHEREAS

1. The First Party is a Physiotherapy and Paramedical Sciences College at Morodhat, Indore, Being a Constituent unit of Index Medical College Hospital Research Center, Malwanchal University (Private University)
2. The Second Party is widely recognized as the pioneer of private healthcare in Dewas (M.P.), and running hospital under name and style of Amaltas Hospital. The hospital has emerged as the foremost integrated healthcare provider in Dewas (M.P.), with other Constituent units that specialize in Medical, Pharmacy, Physiotherapy and Nursing.
3. The First Party is desirous of availing the Training and Internship support at the Hospital of the Second Party for training of its Physiotherapist, Lab Technician; hence approached the Second Party to allow their students of Paramedical Course to explore the clinical hospital beds facilities at Amaltas Hospital, Dewas unit for providing clinical training.
4. The First Party confirms that it will be their responsibility to have all statutory affiliation, recognition and certification from all apex





bodies including the M.P. Paramedical Council, State Government and as may be required from time to time as well as recruit Tutors, Teachers and other teaching, technical and administrative staff of their own College of Paramedical and create all other facilities to provide academic training of the required curriculum programme at their own premises.

5. The Second Party has agreed to allow the students of Nursing School/college of the First Party to come to the hospital and get themselves trained using clinical facilities with the help of existing nursing staff of Hospital, for gaining needed Clinical Training and Experience.
6. The parties have thus entered into this Agreement on the terms as recorded hereinafter.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS UNDER:

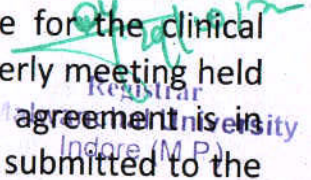
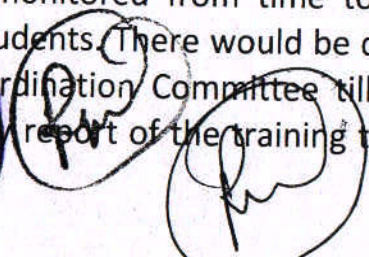
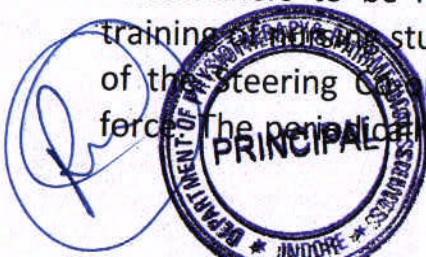
1. The First Party shall be responsible for procurement and maintenance of affiliation and recognition from University, State Paramedical Council, authorities including State Government as may be required from time to time: wherein the Second Party will not be responsible or will not be liable for any de-recognition of the First Party.
2. The First Party shall notify the Second Party in writing in advance, i.e. 15 days before proposed training schedule, about the schedules, time tables and training related activities including clinical examination etc. The Second Party will provide training to the Students of the First Party at Index Department of Physiotherapy and Paramedical Sciences, Malwanchal University Indore.
3. The First Party shall be responsible to inform the Second Party in case of any changes in decisions concerning training activities-such as change in the schedules etc.
4. The First Party agrees to post/depute the students continuously for a period of three (3) months in each academic year.

5. The Second Party agrees to permit/allow prospective students to undergo training in all departments of the Hospital.





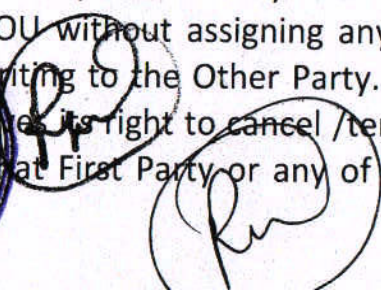
6. The Second Party will not be responsible for the payment of any Stipend, Incentives or compensations to the students of the First Party. The Parties hereto agrees that students of the First Party in any way shall not be considered as staff, employee or officer of Second Party. By entering into this Agreement no relationship of employer and employee is deemed to be established between the Second Party and students of the First Party.
7. This Memorandum of Understanding shall not create and shall not be deemed to have created a joint venture, a partnership, a principal-agent relationship or any other business organization or entity. Nothing herein shall be construed to constitute either party as the agent of the other party for any purpose whatsoever, and neither party shall bind or attempt to bind the other party to any contract or the performance of any obligation, or represent to any third party that it has any right to enter into any binding obligation on the other party's behalf. Each Party shall execute its obligations or duties hereunder at its own expense without recourse to the other Party.
8. The Second Party will not be responsible for any accident, hazards if any happen to the First Party's Students at the hospital site. Both Parties hereto agree to indemnify each other in case of any accident, hazards to the interns at hospital site.
9. The Second Party reserves its right to alter, reject or change the clinical (practical) training time tables and schedules, to safeguard the interest of the patients, its own training activities, programmes, events etc. or without assignment of any reason whatsoever in any unforeseeable circumstances.
10. Students of the First Party shall be strictly bound to follow rules, regulation and policies enforced from time to time by the Second Party. First Party will submit the attendance record/ Physical Record of training on monthly basis to the Second Party.
11. Both the parties accepted to constitute a Steering Co-ordination Committee with due representation of Senior Academicians and Practitioners to be monitored from time to time for the clinical training of the students. There would be quarterly meeting held of the steering co-ordination committee till this agreement is in force. The periodical report of the training to be submitted to the





Unit Head of the Hospital by the Committee.

12. The First Party shall appoint qualified clinical instructor/tutor exclusively for students, who will monitor them during the training period. He/She will monitor attendance, training & also take all responsibilities of students. He/She will be present in the patient area with the students at the time of training period going as per the shift schedule decided respectively. In addition to that Principal of the college will also supervise activity of Trainee /Students.
13. After completion of training, if required their evaluation would be done by the hospital. If the results are found poor, those students will be considered for extended training for some days as decided by the Second Party.
14. The First Party shall be responsible to provide I-Card and Uniform to their students and staff members to allow them entry into the premises of the Second Party.
15. The existing nursing staff of the Second Party will support student of the First Party in clinical training and experience. The Staff of Second Party will cooperate fully to the students in Clinical training. The Second Party shall not be responsible to recruit any special staff to support any clinical training to the Students.
16. First Party will not do any such activities/ programs /claim such thing which will bring disrepute/bad name to Second Party & attached institutions.
17. The MOU will not give any right temporary or perpetual on any moveable/immovable / intellectual assets/facilities or any other objects of Second party to First party by virtue of this agreement.
18. This Memorandum of Understanding will remain in force initially for period of three (03) years from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018 to 1<sup>st</sup> September 2021. It will automatically expire on 13<sup>th</sup> September 2024 unless renewed for a further period of 3 years. Either Party may cancel /terminate this MOU without assigning any reasons by giving one month notice in writing to the Other Party. Without prejudice, The Second Party reserves its right to cancel /terminate this MOU in the event it is found that First Party or any of its students have acted





contrary to the obligations contained in this MOU. The decision of the Second Party in such cases shall be final.

19. No modification, variation, waiver or amendment of any term & condition of this MoU shall be effective unless and until it shall be reduced to writing and signed by both the parties.
20. The Parties agree that the terms and conditions of this Memorandum of Understanding are confidential and shall not be disclosed to any third party without prior written consent from the non-disclosing party, unless law requires such disclosure.

## Master Service Agreement

This Master Service Agreement is entered on this day of, ("31-AUG-2022") by and

BETWEEN

**Canvass Clinical research Services Pvt. Ltd (CCRSPL)**, (here in after referred to as "SMO") having its registered office at Keshav Imperial, B wing, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, 303, Opposite Shani Mandir, Sitabuldi, Nagpur-440020, Maharashtra, India

AND

**Index Medical College Hospital and Research Centre** (here in after referred to as "Investigator") with offices at Index City, NH-59A, Nemawar Road, Dist-Indore-452016 (M.P.)

(Here in after referred to as "Site")

**WHEREAS**, Index Medical College Hospital and Research Centre (in a practice of providing health care) a health care practice and/or research site conducting clinical trials ("Studies") and desires to obtain the services of Canvass Clinical Research Services Pvt. Ltd in obtaining and managing new studies conducted by sponsors and Contract Research Organization (CRO's) for SITE;

**WHEREAS**, Canvass Clinical Research Services Pvt. Ltd, a Site Management Organization (SMO) is in the business of obtaining and managing studies conducted by sponsors and Contract Research Organization (CRO's) for investigators and investigator sites.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the promises and mutual agreements herein contained and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, it is mutually covenanted and agreed by and between the parties here to as follows:

### **A. Distribution Of Remuneration between CCRSPL & Index Medical College Hospital and Research Centre**

1. Canvass Clinical Research Services Pvt. Ltd shall obtain new studies for Index Medical College Hospital and Research Centre from sponsors and Contract Research Organizations (CRO's) in medical specialty per information provided in the investigative profile and demographics submitted to Canvass Clinical Research Services Pvt. Ltd on an ongoing basis.
2. For Mentioned project's requirement CCRSPL Provides their CRC's for the Project management till completion of project's. CCRSPL CRC's should not be involved any hospital related work other then delegated clinical trial or nor involved for other SMO/CRO related work which has not association with CCRSPL.
3. CCRSPL is responsible for the payment of CRC's for their delegated clinical trial.
4. CCRSPL will manage Project management from feasibility to archival of the mentioned clinical trial.
5. CCRSPL provides any study specific equipment require during the conduct of clinical trial. Hospital should have Deep freezer, Freezer, Centrifuge, weighing machine, height chart, desktop, Printer during the site selection visit. As per the trial requirement CCRSPL should also provide equipment's which would be procure back after close out.

- CCRSPL has the rights to take decision about this equipment Institute/Hospital should be responsible for arranging printer, internet connection.
6. CCRSPL Procure all the mentioned equipment's for the investigator site after completion of projects. Till the completion of the projects CCRSPL will take care of these equipment's & equipment's belong to the CCRSPL.
  7. In any case trial is not completed or terminated by sponsor or CRO or the site is not capable to enroll a single patient in the mentioned projects then CCRSPL has rights to decide about the equipment provided by CCRSPL.
  8. CCRSPL should not share start up amount with PI & Institute/Hospital. All CTA related discussion was done by CCRSPL Head.
  9. CCRSPL should responsible for only study related stationary & coordinate with CRC appointed by CCRSPL.

**B. Term of Agreement**

The term of this agreement shall be for a period of 1 Year from 31-AUG-2022 to 30-AUG-2023.

**C. Relationship of the Parties**

1. Index Medical College Hospital and Research Centre and CCRSPL are independent parties. Both parties agree that their relationship is that of an independent contractor not employer and employee.
2. Neither party shall have express or implies rights not did authority to assume or create any obligation or responsibility on behalf of or in the name of other party by reason of this agreement, except as provided in this agreement.
3. It is understood that Index Medical College Hospital and Research Centre and CCRSPL shall exercise no control over the activities and operations of each other.
4. Index Medical College Hospital and Research Centre shall communicate all relevant aspects of the Clinical Trial to the parties intending to participate in the trial or their lawful representatives and shall obtain voluntary signed written informed consent form all prospective patients prior to start of any study related procedure.
5. Index Medical College Hospital and Research Centre shall also be responsible for supporting sponsor/ Clinical Research Organization in resolving any technical issues encountered during the performance of clinical trial.
6. It is further agreed between Index Medical College Hospital and Research Centre and CCRSPL that shall strictly adhere to the privacy laws, regulations and other standards.

**D. NDCT 19 and ICH GCP Compliance**

1. Index Medical College Hospital and Research Centre agrees to comply with all requirements of International Conference of Harmonization Good Clinical Practices (ICH-GCP) and NDCT19 and all future national and international regulations, requirements writing promulgated there-under.

#### E. Confidentiality

1. The parties here to recognize and agree that due to the complex and competitive nature of business, the confidentiality of information concerning both parties is of critical importance. Either party shall not, either during or after the term of this Agreement, disclose to any third party and confidential information and all information and information related to work or the business of either party without the written consent of either party. A Canvass Clinical Research Services Pvt. Ltd agrees that it shall not during, or at any time after the termination of this Agreement, directly or indirectly disclose or use any information of any reason whatsoever, without the prior written consent of Index Medical College Hospital and Research Centre in each instance, provided that the following disclosures and use shall be permitted hereunder:

- Information may be furnished to any licensing authority or government agency;
- Information may be supplied pursuant to legal process; and
- Information may be reviewed by Canvass Clinical Research Services Pvt. Ltd accountants and professional advisers.

2. Index Medical College Hospital and Research Centre shall not disclose to any third party any and all information about new studies received from Canvass Clinical Research Services Pvt. Ltd.

#### F. Indemnification

- Index Medical College Hospital and Research Centre shall indemnify and hold harmless Canvass Clinical Research Services Pvt. Ltd against all losses, claims, liabilities, damages and expenses of any nature, directly or indirectly arising out of any act or omission by. Index Medical College Hospital and Research Centre, its agents, directors or employees.
- Canvass Clinical Research Services Pvt. Ltd shall indemnify and hold harmless Index Medical College Hospital and Research Centre against any or all losses, claims, liabilities, damages and expenses of any nature, directly or indirectly arising out of any act or omission by Canvass Clinical Research Services Pvt. Ltd, its agents, directors or employees.

In no event will either party be required to indemnify or hold harmless the other for the other's negligence or gross negligence.

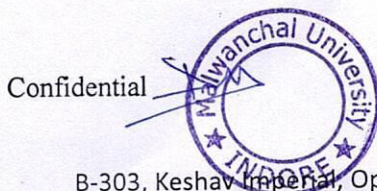
#### G. Archival of Study Documents:

It is understood that after the completion of the study at site, the study documents shall be archived at site for the duration of period as per the requirement of ICH-GCP , NDCT 19 and as per sponsor requirement. Ltd shall suggest the name of the arbitrator and the dispute shall be referred to the said arbitrator and the decision of the arbitrator shall be binding on both the parties.

It is also agreed between the Index Medical College Hospital and Research Centre and Canvass Clinical Research Services Pvt. Ltd that, the provision of Arbitrator and Conciliation Act 1996 shall be applicable.

It is further agreed between the Index Medical College Hospital and Research Centre and Canvass Clinical Research Services Pvt. Ltd that, the Indore Court will have jurisdiction for the disputes arising between the parties.

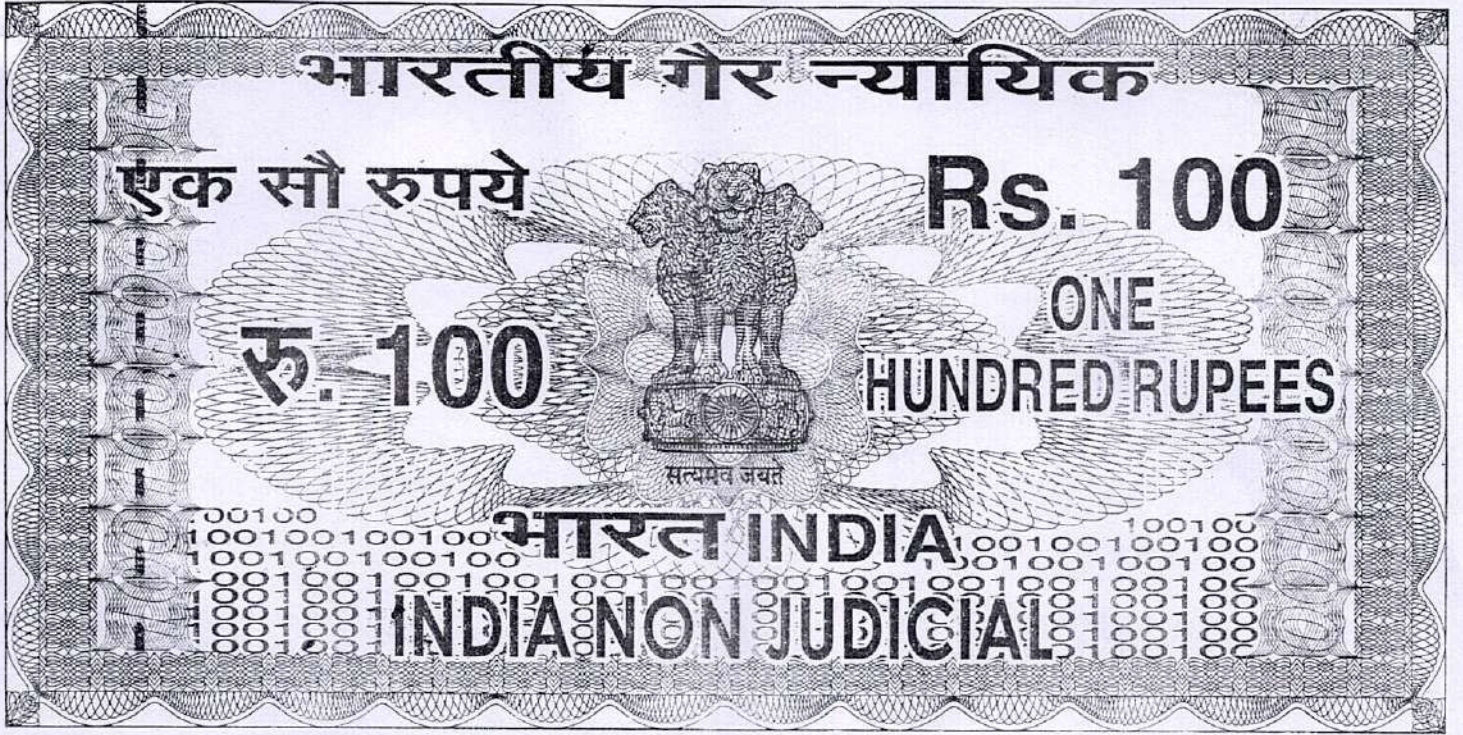





## 2.0 SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES






Index Institute of Dental Sciences and Darshan Dental College and Hospital aims to undertake cooperation in areas that may include, but are not restricted to, the following:

#### 5.0 RENEWAL, TERMINATION AND AMENDMENT






5.1 This MOU shall remain in force for a period of five years from the date of the last signature. This MOU may be extended by the written consent of the parties.

The Investigator and study team will report to the Reviewing Committee by email / letter (in standard detailed format) all Adverse Events, Serious Adverse Events and all deviations related to Protocol, related to applicable guidelines, related to local regulations and any other general, situational and any other deviation irrespective of severity of the effect of the deviation or event promptly. Any delay in the same may result in immediate suspension of conduct of the trial at the Investigator site and result in a for-cause audit and/or inspection.
6. Reviewing Committee will have access to all requested data of study subjects as and when required for review.
7. Reviewing Committee may conduct audit and/or inspection of the study conduct and related data as and when required.
8. Reviewing Committee expects information, notification, pre-initiation & pre-approval (wherever necessary) of any change or update in any of the study Protocol, documents, procedure or any other change in connection or in relation to the study.
9. In the event of any substantial amendments being made to the Protocol, the amendments shall be signed by the Investigator and shall be implemented by the Research Staff as required by the Sponsor or CRO after approval of the amendments by the Competent Authority and a favourable opinion of the Reviewing Ethics Committee.
10. Reviewing Committee needs to be informed of any protocol waiver granted to any subject; in case of any emergency/life threatening circumstances.
11. The Parties shall conduct the Clinical Trial in accordance with:

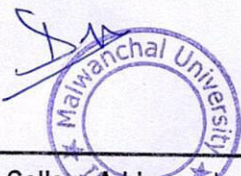

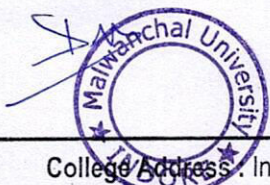



c. If it becomes apparent, following confirmation of the Ethics Committee, that continuation of the Clinical Trial cannot serve a scientific purpose, and this is notified to the Ethics Committee;

d. if the Sponsor and/or the Institution and/or the Investigator become or are declared insolvent or a petition in bankruptcy has been filed against it or if one of them is dissolved;

e. if circumstances beyond a Party's control occur that render continuation of the Clinical Trial unreasonable.

f. if one of the parties fails to comply with the obligations arising from the Agreement and, if capable of remedy, is not remedied within 15 days after receipt of notice from the other Party specifying the non-compliance and requiring its remedy, unless failure to comply is not in reasonable proportion to the premature termination of the Clinical Trial.

In all circumstances causing the early termination of this Agreement pursuant to clauses above, the Sponsor shall confer with the Principal Investigator and Institution shall use their best endeavors to minimize any inconvenience or harm to Clinical Trial Subjects caused by the premature termination of the Clinical Trial.   - 2.4. To provide support in conduction of Refresher Courses, Orientation courses, Research methodology programs and faculty development program.
  - 2.5. Promotion of Research Activities in common interest area.
  - 2.6. Privileged invitation for event(s) / program(s) organized by MU(limited number of guests).
  - 2.7. Display and information about facilities and opportunities at SPU in the reception galleryMU
  - 2.8. Support in execution, monitoring and evaluation process of various research activities.
  - 2.9. Access and usage of knowledge resource centre, infrastructural facilities such as convention centre at special 'Academic Associates' discounted charges.
  - 2.11. The facilities for students and faculties at concessional charges.
  - 2.12. Consultation, unbiased evolution of various educational processes asMU Academic & Administrative Audit program.
  - 2.13. Information and invitation for research events conducted by other associate members for associates' network.

**ARTICLE 3: CO-ORDINATION AND NODAL OFFICER**

No alterations, additions or modification hereto shall be valid and binding unless the same are reduced to writing and signed by both the Parties.


##### 6.4 Non-Exclusive Discussions

- (b) discussions about that information that may occur before, at the same time, or after disclosure of the information. This MOU and all confidential information exchanged between the Parties pursuant to this MOU shall be held in confidence.
- 6.5.2. Neither Party nor any of the affiliates shall make any public announcement about the MOU and /or the scope of proposed engagement, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Any public announcement so made, shall be as outlined in the Article 2 of this MOU.
- 6.6. **License and Intellectual Property Rights**
- 6.6.1. No license is granted under this MOU to either Party under any of the other Party's intellectual property rights, either expressly, by implication, inducement, estoppel or otherwise. Both Parties understand and acknowledge that grant of any such license shall always be express and in writing.
- 6.6.2. Both parties will take all necessary steps to protect the knowledge documents and intellectual Properties generated during the process or shared by the parties.
- 6.7. **Conflict of Interest**
- Neither of the parties believes that the Collaboration contemplated by this MOU raise any actual or potential conflicts of interest. The parties agree that this MOU and the negotiation of the same (and any other agreements entered into in connection herewith) are independent of any past, present or potential future arrangements, and are not connected to an existing business relationship between either of the parties.

#### ARTICLE 7: TERMINATION

- 7.1 This MOU shall also terminate without liability to either party if otherwise agreed to by the Parties in writing with a notice period of 1 month.
- 7.2 **Survival and binding Nature** 7.2.1. Except for Clause 6 (Terms), Cause 7 (Termination) and 9 (Dispute Settlement) of this MOU, nothing contained in this MOU is intended to be or shall be construed in any way to be legally binding on any of the Parties.
- 7.2.2. Except as set forth elsewhere in this MOU, Clause 6 (Terms), Cause 7 (Termination), 9 (Dispute Settlement) shall survive the expiry or termination of this MOU.

#### ARTICLE 8: DISPUTE SETTLEMENT

- 8.1. **Governing Law and Jurisdiction**
- 8.1.1. This MOU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Republic of Bharat. The arbitration proceedings will be conducted in Hindi, English or any Bharatiya Language and the seat of arbitration will be New Delhi.







### BETWEEN

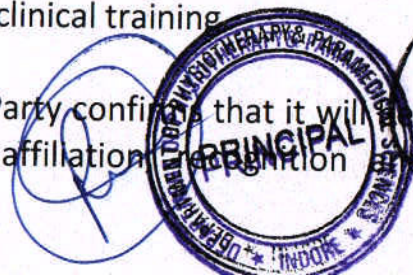

Amaltas Institute of medical sciences, Dewas, registered under the "Mayank Welfare Society, Indore" of the Second Part.

### **WHEREAS**

1. The First Party is a Physiotherapy and Paramedical Sciences College at Morodhat, Indore, Being a Constituent unit of Index Medical College Hospital Research Center, Malwanchal University (Private University)
2. The Second Party is widely recognized as the pioneer of private healthcare in Dewas (M.P.), and running hospital under name and style of Amaltas Hospital. The hospital has emerged as the foremost integrated healthcare provider in Dewas (M.P.), with other Constituent units that specialize in Medical, Pharmacy, Physiotherapy and Nursing.
3. The First Party is desirous of availing the Training and Internship support at the Hospital of the Second Party for training of its Physiotherapist, Lab Technician; hence approached the Second Party to allow their students of Paramedical Course to explore the clinical hospital beds facilities at Amaltas Hospital, Dewas unit for providing clinical training
4. The First Party confirms that it will be responsible to have all statutory affiliation, recognition and certification from all apex

Paramedical Council, State Government and as may be required from time to time as well as recruit Tutors, Teachers and other teaching, technical and administrative staff of their own College of Paramedical and create all other facilities to provide academic training of the required curriculum programme at their own premises.

5. The Second Party has agreed to allow the students of Nursing School/college of the First Party to come to the hospital and get themselves trained using clinical facilities with the help of existing nursing staff of Hospital, for gaining needed Clinical Training and Experience.
6. The parties have thus entered into this Agreement on the terms as recorded hereinafter.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS UNDER:

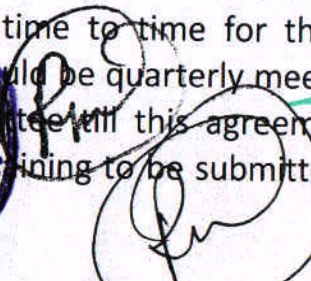
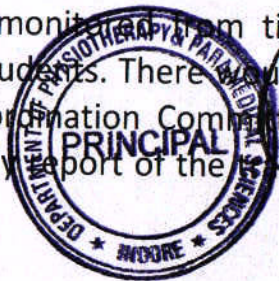
1. The First Party shall be responsible for procurement and maintenance of affiliation and recognition from University, State Paramedical Council, authorities including State Government as may be required from time to time: wherein the Second Party will not be responsible or will not be liable for any de-recognition of the First Party.
2. The First Party shall notify the Second Party in writing in advance, i.e. 15 days before proposed training schedule, about the schedules, time tables and training related activities including clinical examination etc. The Second Party will provide training to the Students of the First Party at Index Department of Physiotherapy and Paramedical Sciences, Malwanchal University Indore.
3. The First Party shall be responsible to inform the Second Party in case of any changes in decisions concerning training activities-such as change in the schedules etc.
4. The First Party agrees to post/depute the students continuously for a period of three (3) months in each academic year.
5. The Second Party agrees to permit/allow prospective students to undergo training in all departments of the Hospital.

6. The Second Party will not be responsible for the payment of any Stipend, Incentives or compensations to the students of the First Party. The Parties hereto agrees that students of the First Party in any way shall not be considered as staff, employee or officer of Second Party. By entering into this Agreement no relationship of employer and employee is deemed to be established between the Second Party and students of the First Party.
7. This Memorandum of Understanding shall not create and shall not be deemed to have created a joint venture, a partnership, a principal-agent relationship or any other business organization or entity. Nothing herein shall be construed to constitute either party as the agent of the other party for any purpose whatsoever, and neither party shall bind or attempt to bind the other party to any contract or the performance of any obligation, or represent to any third party that it has any right to enter into any binding obligation on the other party's behalf. Each Party shall execute its obligations or duties hereunder at its own expense without recourse to the other Party.
8. The Second Party will not be responsible for any accident, hazards if any happen to the First Party's Students at the hospital site. Both Parties hereto agree to indemnify each other in case of any accident, hazards to the interns at hospital site.
9. The Second Party reserves its right to alter, reject or change the clinical (practical) training time tables and schedules, to safeguard the interest of the patients, its own training activities, programmes, events etc. or without assignment of any reason whatsoever in any unforeseeable circumstances.
10. Students of the First Party shall be strictly bound to follow rules, regulation and policies enforced from time to time by the Second Party. First Party will submit the attendance record/ Physical Record of training on monthly basis to the Second Party.
11. Both the parties accepted to constitute a Steering Co-ordination Committee with due representation of Senior Academicians and Practitioners to be monitored from time to time for the clinical training of nursing students. There shall be quarterly meeting held of the Steering Co-ordination Committee while this agreement is in force. The periodically report of the training to be submitted to the

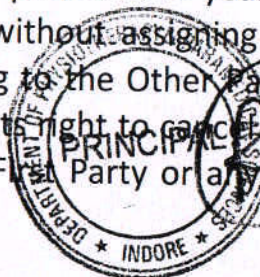
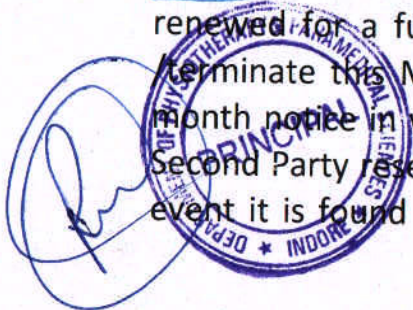

14. The First Party shall be responsible to provide I-Card and Uniform to their students and staff members to allow them entry into the premises of the Second Party.
15. The existing nursing staff of the Second Party will support student of the First Party in clinical training and experience. The Staff of Second Party will cooperate fully to the students in Clinical training. The Second Party shall not be responsible to recruit any special staff to support any clinical training to the Students.
16. First Party will not do any such activities/ programs /claim such thing which will bring disrepute/bad name to Second Party & attached institutions.
17. The MOU will not give any right temporary or perpetual on any moveable/immovable / intellectual assets/facilities or any other objects of Second party to First party by virtue of this agreement.
18. This Memorandum of Understanding will remain in force initially for period of three (03) years from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018 to 1<sup>st</sup> September 2021. It will automatically expire on 13<sup>th</sup> September 2024 unless renewed for a further period of 3 years. Either Party may cancel/terminate this MOU without assigning any reasons by giving one month notice in writing to the Other Party. Without prejudice, The Second Party reserves its right to cancel/terminate this MoU in the event it is found that First Party or any of its students have acted






contrary to the obligations contained in this MOU. The decision of the Second Party in such cases shall be final.




