Career Guidance Workshop - Courses and specializations after

MBBS: Non Clinical Career Options

REPORT

A workshop titled 'Courses and specializations after MBBS Courses and

specializations after MBBS: Non Clinical Career Options for final year MBBS

students and interns was held on 17/09/21, regarding their career guidance after their

internship completion.

This workshop was done in the auditorium, at Index Medical College, Hospital &

Research Centre, Indore. The resource persons for the workshop were Dr. Pankaj Devi

Dayal, Dept. of Anaesthesia & Dr. Pramod Sakhi, Dept. of Radio-diagnosis.

The resources person started the talk describing the increased burnout related to

medical profession. While practicing medicine is the reason people become doctors yet

there are many other fields one can pursue if clinical work seems too overwhelming.

He discussed some common options:

1. Medical Writer. There are several ways to earn income as a writer. Most

physicians automatically think of publishing a book. This is but one option that

allows for earning income. There are opportunities to be a paid blog writer, test

question contributor, and medical freelance writer. There are a plethora of

resources available both online and offline on how to make the transition to a

successful medical writer.

Many physicians are becoming savvy and making their way into the online business world. There are several options including the online learning industry, classes, webinars, and even self-published and PLR book sales. Additionally, becoming an online marketer can produce a solid secondary source of income with the right training and resources. There are many books and marketing coaches that can get one on the pathway to creating ones successful online business.

3. Consulting. Unbeknownst to many physicians, medical expertise is frequently sought after by pharmaceutical companies and biotech companies when they are creating, testing and investigating new products.

4. Expert witness. It is true that doctors need legal advice at times. Whether defending a physician who is not liable or providing testimony for a physician who is liable, this is an area where physicians can create a non-medical career utilizing their clinical expertise. Additionally, expert witnesses can make a decent income without having to work 60 to 80 hours a week.

5. Concierge medicine. For physicians who want to continue to provide quality patient care but on their terms, concierge medicine may be a good option. With this style of practice, one can see patients for longer times, see fewer patients overall, and give more personalized care. Furthermore, since this is a cash-based model, one doesn't have to worry about fighting with insurance for payment as one always receive 100 percent of what one bill.

6. Public speaking / live events. If one is someone who loves to speak, train and be on stage, utilizing ones medical degree to educate the masses may be the pathway for one. Physicians can earn a significant living speaking for conferences, hospital organizations and societies, and corporations on various health and medical topics. Additionally, physicians can be motivational speakers, hold retreats and training events for other physicians.

7. Virtual medicine. The rise telemedicine has brought a new awareness to the capabilities of the virtual practice. Not only can telemedicine provide access to those who otherwise may not have it, but in many cases, it's reimbursable by insurance. It also provides flexibility for the physician practicing, allowing them to be anywhere while seeing their patients. There are large telemedicine corporations, but one can easily start one's own virtual practice as long as one are abiding by telemedicine laws and licensing compliance. Furthermore, the concierge model could also be applied to the virtual practice.

8. Physician coaching. Coaching is becoming an increasingly popular career choice for many professions. Physicians have the opportunity to provide coaching to patients, other physicians, or hospital executives. Coaching areas include wellness, nutrition, leadership, business or career transition.

9. Television / radio personality. There are many physicians who have turned to television or radio as a non-medical career option.

for final year MBBS students and interns was held on 18/04/22, regarding their

Career guidance after their internship completion.

This workshop was done in the auditorium, at Index Medical College, Hospital &

Research Centre, Indore. The resource persons for the workshop were Dr. Girish

Verma, Dept. of Anaesthesiology & Dr. Kuldeep Virani, Dept. of Surgery.

The resource persons started the talk with stating that there are a wide variety of

opportunities available after completing MBBS, the decision has to be which is the one

that matches their interests and life goals.

Thorough research on all the options and preparing an action plan save one from

confusion in the future. The various options that were discussed were as follows:

• Biomedical engineering - It is suitable for candidates who are interested in

machines as well as their mechanisms. It involves developing instruments that

are used for rendering healthcare services in a better way.

MD/MS/Diploma: MBBS graduates often choose a 3-year degree course or a 2-

year diploma as their career path. It prepares a candidate to be a specialist

Index Medical College, Hospital & R:C.,INDORE doctor. Post-graduation can be done with different specializations such as general surgery, gynecology, internal medicine, pediatrics, and others. Entrance tests such as AIIMS PG, and NEET are conducted for admission to colleges in India for pursuing this. The super specializations available for MD holders are Doctor of Medicine, Cardiology, Neurology, and Nephrology. Similarly, the super specialization options available for MS holders are Master of Chirurgery (M.Ch), Neurosurgery, Plastic Surgery, Urology, Trauma, and Orthopaedics.

- Customary courses: Candidates who wish to pursue degrees in medicine from universities outside India, need to appear for a different set of entrance tests. The eligibility criteria are an MBBS degree or an equivalent from a recognized university. For example, to join colleges in the USA, the USMLE exam needs to be cleared by PG aspirants. Appearing for the AMC test and clearing it makes you eligible for a college in Australia. Then you can choose a specialization in MD, MS, or a diploma course.
- Diplomate of National Board or DNB: The National Board of Examinations
 offers DNB, which has recognition from MCI.
- Clinical Research: There is a huge demand for clinical researchers in India. Research opportunities are offered by renowned colleges such as CIMAP, Centre for Cellular and Molecular Biology, and St. John's Research Institute, and Indian Council for Medical Research (ICMR). Candidates can even join WHO. They can pursue PhD in AIIMS, PGI, NIMHANS, and Tata Institute of Fundamental Research in Mumbai.

overall development. For this, candidates can pursue a Master's in Public Health

and continue a career in the same.

M.Sc in different fields: MBBS graduates can pursue M.Sc in Anesthesia,

Biochemistry, Anatomy, Forensic Medicine, ENT, Dermatology, Venereology &

Leprosy, Geriatrics, Aerospace Medicine, and others.

M.Tech in Biomedical engineering: MBBS graduates can pursue this course

which is offered by the IITs. Those interested in investing in medical machines

and instruments for enhancing the healthcare provided by the hospitals will find it

interesting.

Masters in Medical Science and Technology or MMST: IITs offer this course

and involve medical biotechnology, bioinformatics, healthcare imaging, and

others.

Masters in Health Administration or MHA: This is a 3-year post-graduation

degree in health administration. This course enables students to develop skills

for managing big speciality healthcare centres, insurance companies, and others.

Jobs after this comes with very good pay.

A workshop titled 'Courses and specializations after MBBS In the field of Medicine in India' for final year MBBS students and interns was held on 22/04/22, regarding their Career guidance after their internship completion.

This workshop was done in the auditorium, at Index Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, Indore. The resource persons for the workshop were Dr. Anjali Singh, Dept. of Pathology & Dr. Anuradha Jain, Dept. of Paediatrics.

In India most doctors who have completed the MBBS program and are ready for practicing independently opt to do a post graduate program of their choice. There are five streams one can pursue – Master of Surgery (MS), Doctor of Medicine (MD), Post Graduate Diploma, CPS diploma and Diploma of National Board (DNB). Each has its merits and demerits and at the end, it is the enthusiasm and willingness to commit oneself that determines the outcome. Though there are many programs that are open to do after MBBS, the most popular courses are restricted to a few. After completion 3 years of MS degree candidate becomes a surgeon in a particular branch. Next in order is MD; The course duration is three years, and after completion, candidates can join a

hospital or choose to set up their own practice, in a particular branch. The most preferred PG program is Radiology/Radio Diagnosis. MS (Orthopaedics) and MS (Surgery) stands after radiology.

If you have a liking for only teaching profession, then non clinical branch e.g. Anatomy is for you. It is a 3-year post-graduation after MBBS. You will study the bodily structures of living beings, as well as living organisms.

This workshop was done in the auditorium, at Index Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, Indore. The resource persons for the workshop were Dr. Atul Kumar Vyas, Dept. of Surgery & Dr. Deepak Sharma,, Dept. of Medicine.

The speaker discussed various job opportunities open after MBBS as follows:

- **Junior doctor:** This is the primary role for any MBBS graduate which involves caring for the safety of patients and providing them proper healthcare.
- Doctors: This is the next stage after completion of the final year of residency and incubation period as a junior doctor. This involves caring for the patients independently, which makes one fit for jobs at prime healthcare organizations with good pay and position.
- Physician: Candidates who are reluctant to be involved in the hustle of the emergency department will find a physician to be a good option. This involves

exercising medical expertise for serving patients in conditions except for an emergency.

- Lecturer at a medical college: Candidates who are interested in the teaching profession can become a lecturer at any medical college. This is a lucrative career option but involves long hours of teaching.
- Researcher: There are dedicated research centres for different government agencies, medical institutions, and hospitals. Candidates interested in research work can work and be involved in medicine's non-clinical side. The research is based on the needs of the current situation such as ongoing diseases, medicine for making progress in the healthcare field.
- Scientist: Government agencies, hospitals, and research institutes have the
 position of scientists open. The job involves efforts to help the world with
 discoveries and findings, some of which can bring a revolution too.
- Medical writer: An MBBS candidate can work for institutes, hospitals, startups, journals, or any healthcare firm in the healthcare sector, for creating medical articles. They are the right candidates as they are aware of the medical terminology and can use them correctly based on the context. It lets a candidate express his wisdom and justify a brand's cause and vision.
- Healthcare Informatics: Candidates who are good with numbers can find this as
 an interesting career option. It involves dealing with medical knowledge as well
 as analytics, for reaching the peak of medical data analytics.

They are initially trained in military camps to ensure that they are in synchronization with the army personnel. Then they are appointed to a permanent position to assist the army and defense personnel during emergencies.

Hospital management: Candidates who have completed MBBS and have management skills can opt for management roles in healthcare firms. This job role involves managing the regular services in healthcare centres to ensure better functionality. MBBS candidates who have completed additional management courses such as health administration and hospital management are often recruited for this position.

Jobs in government health service department: This includes central as well as state government jobs in healthcare departments. Recruitment for these positions is done through the CMS(Combined Medical Services) exam conducted by UPSC. On clearing the exam, candidates get jobs in government hospitals, dispensaries, railways, and municipal corporations. The jobs involve administrative tasks and are usually permanent positions.

 Sports Medicine: There has been a rise in medical graduates opting for the sports industry as this has gained a large customer base with time.

 Entrepreneurship: Just like people from any other profession can practice entrepreneurship, so do MBBS graduates can if they come up with some good ideas or alternatives for an ongoing issue.

Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS) is also a very dynamic medical education branch. Considering the career opportunities in Dentistry in India and abroad, Index Institute of Dental Sciences organised a career counselling lecture on the top alternative career paths after BDS other than MDS, specifically focussing on opportunities abroad.

The speaker for the event was Dr. Gauri Samvatsarkar who was a faculty member earlier and is currently working with the University of Malaysia.

Dr Gauri gave a very inspirational speech at the beginning encouraging participants to come out of their comfort zone. She addressed the participants saying that first of all you need to decide where do you want go?

Then she briefed about some of the countries and their requirements to practice or join higher studies after BDS. In Japan China and Russia you can't practice as a dentist without clearing a language exam with B2 level of fluency including a licensing exam. If you need another job, you can work with NGO to give away English language training to support your expenses. Another preferred option she mentioned was Canada, which has several options for candidates who are looking for options to study or looking for a bright career through immigration pathway.

Canada has dentistry as a regulated and excellent profession. One can work in Canada as an associate dentist, dental assistant, Volunteer, Dental service director, General practitioner and Research assistant. For applicants who have completed their BDS and want to be dentist in Canada need to give qualifying exams which would satisfy the requirements of competencies as per Canadian standards. Students need to give exams conducted by NDEB or National Dental Examining Board of Canada. Once you have cleared the exam one can practice dental surgeon or can pursue further studies. On clearing a course one must be qualified or certified by the commission of dental accreditation of Canada or CDAC, which is degree granting organization for the dentists in Canada.

Few students were keen to know about the South East as they had heard about excellent salary packages there. Dr. Gauri mentioned that, in the middle east preferably saudi countries you can directly get a job as a Dentist only after having minimum 2 years of job experience and after clearing an exam. The opportunities are better if you have done your post graduation also.

For applicants who have already completed their dentistry degree from India or BDS one can validate the subjects of degree as per Australian university standards. Dr. Gauri said that this will ensure that one can pursue further study options or look for professional career pathway ahead. One can validate dentist degree by meeting the IELTS requirement of minimum 7 or level B in all parts of the OTS. Australian Dental Council evaluated the documents and once you have completed your ADC requirement and have English title you can register for written and oral examination for your dentistry knowledge.

UK is another destination often preferred by students. For settling in UK as a dentist one needs to give ORE test which is a licensing exam conducted by British Dental Council. The exam is conducted twice year –April and September. The exam is based on UK dental curriculum and has two parts of theory and practical aspect. For giving an ORE test one can apply for tourist visa, further one has the option of UKBA visa for students planning to appear in ORE or PLAB. Further, one has the option of opting for masters programs both clinical and non-clinical.

In European countries it is even fierce. You have to do vocational courses and have to clear licensing exam including language proficiency text.

Same thing goes with USA. Even to work as a hygienist you need a degree to prove it plus additional requirements starting from appearing on and exam to repeating the whole course.

Dr. Gauri explained about the availability of immigration consultants and various web portals wherein you can register and gain information regarding the vacancies.

She also explained about the importance of creating a LinkedIn profile. She gave tips and tricks for improving the language proficiency and clearing the licensing exams. Websites like duo-lingo can provide a good help in learning new languages.

The session ended with an interactive Q and A session with an enthusiastic participation by the students.



REPORT ON

The part of seminar was delivered by Dr. RIZWAN KHAN, He started his session by giving a basic introduction on Pharmacy and then move towards his medical store. It is a shop were pharmacist dispense medicine to the patient. The basic duty of a pharmacist is to check prescriptions from physicians before dispensing the medication to the patients to ensure that the patients don't receive the wrong drugs or take an incorrect dose of medicine. The purpose of the drug license is to grant permission to allow individuals to engage in businesses related to drugs and cosmetics. Types of drug license are as follows:

Manufacturing License License issued to a business that manufactures drugs inclusive of allopathic/homoeopathy medicines.

Sale License - License issued for the sale of drugs.

Wholesale License – A drug wholesaler must obtain a wholesale license.

Retail License – A retail license is required for the retail sale of drugs. A retail sale means the sale of drugs or cosmetics for the consumption of the end consumer.

Import License – License is issued to any dealer importing the products for the manufacturing of drugs.

The next half of the seminar was delivered by Mr. LOKENDRA JAIN, he explained about the Qualification for license and documents required for drug license.

What are the qualifications required for obtaining a drug license?

The qualification or eligibility of a competent person for retail and wholesale drug license or pharmacist is as follows:

A. For retail drug license:

- B. Pharmacy/D. Pharmacy degree holder
- Registration with State Pharmacy Council

B. For Wholesale drug license:

- B Pharmacy /D. Pharmacy degree holder
- Registered with State Pharmacy Council
- A graduate with one year of experience of dealing in drugs or an undergraduate having four years experience of dealing in drugs

Documents required for drug license are as follows:

- A challan of Rs 3,000
- Affidavit of the proprietor on Rs 20 stamp paper
- Self-attested copies of education certificate and identity proof of proprietor
- Affidavit of a registered pharmacist or competent person
- Self-attested copies of education certificate and identity proof of registered pharmacist or competent person
- Experience certificate of a competent person
- Blueprint of a plan layout of proposed premises
- Copy of refrigerator bill
- Either rent agreement or ownership document of the premises
- 5 photos each of proprietor, and either the registered pharmacist or competent person

By this she concluded his session, and generally interacts with the students who were interested to open medical store.
