



Methodology and Criteria for Assessment of Learning Policy on Slow and Advanced Learners

Introduction:

A classroom has a plethora of students that have different abilities to grasp a topic. A few can comprehend a topic at a faster pace, while a few may be slower. Therefore, it becomes essential to determine the abilities of a student. Based on the ability determined, few students may require only guidance while the other lot may need diligence as well as structured attention.

Assessment of the learning levels of the students:

The Concept of Advanced Learners:

The term "Advanced learners" refer to the students who understand a taught topic relatively faster than the other students in the class and attain high scores. They have more potential and talent as well as better retaining, creativity, critical thinking and contextualization practices than the others in the class. These students are indeed more hard working and are with better academic understanding, as well.


The Concept of Slow Learners:

The slow learners mostly lag in their academic pursuit and find it difficult to understand the subject. They may often require a relatively more amount of time to understand and grasp a subject when compared to the others. They may find it difficult to understand, comprehend and retain a subject. The poor performance may not be a sign of poor capacity or talent but may be due to inappropriate teaching methods, socio-economic background, lack of motivation and support, unorganized learning practices or even the inability to converse in the devised medium of instructions.

Objectives:

The primary intent of the assessment is:

1. To involve modern pedagogical methods and ICT enabled teaching-learning to promote Student-centric teaching-learning.
2. To develop significant strategies and scientific implementations to benefit both the advanced and slow learners.
3. To encourage the advanced learners to be excellent achievers.



4. To boost up the confidence of slow learners and minimize the barriers.
5. To enhance the skills in respect of learning processes.
6. To minimize the gap between slow learners and advanced learners.
7. To motivate the innovative and creative mindset.
8. To organize the workshops/seminars/guidance programs for slow learners.
9. To help understand the paper pattern, question pattern, etc.

Process Input:

To start identification of slow and advanced learner process following inputs are needed

1. Preceding examination's overall results
2. Internal Assessment exam/ class test results
3. Formative Assessment by Subject Teachers

Identification of Slow learners and Advanced Learners:

The process to identify slow learners and advanced learners would be conducted after the declaration of the internal exam or after one month of teaching in the academic session. Every department should conduct an assessment test/ objective type test of their subject on the syllabus covered to date to identify slow and advanced learners.

After that, separate lists are prepared for both type of learners for further monitoring and conduction of problem-solving sessions/revision sessions for them. Every subject teacher should assess each student on a scale of 1 to 10. Based on the above parameter a report would be prepared for the whole class for a total of 100%.

The slow learners are picked after the internal marks are released. The criteria to identify the students as slow and advanced learners are on the discretion of the individual departments.


MEASURES for Slow learners: The following measures are adopted to improve the performance of the slow learners.

a) Extra Classes

Extra classes are conducted if there is difficulty in understanding the content to facilitate understanding among the vernacular medium students as well as students who have short attendance.

b) Mentoring

The mentors are actively involved in counselling the students. The parents of the slow learners are called to discuss the remedial measures to facilitate their progress. The students are




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given freedom to express their problems and issues personally which includes language, emotional and academic issues. Once the student's problem are understood, they are handled with empathy.

Faculties are identified and assigned as mentors for all students for constant support and guidance.

c) Counselling Sessions

Students who require professional counselling will be sent to In-House clinical counsellor appointed by the institution. Counselling Sessions are organized for student teachers facing personal problems, with the help of a professional counsellor appointed by the college.

MEASURES for advanced learners: The following measures are adopted to improve the performance of the advanced learners.

- a) Advanced assignments or tasks
- b) Encouraging participation in conferences/ seminars
- c) Researches
- d) ICMR studies

Responsibilities for each department:

1. Conduction regular assessment tests during class and lecture hours.
2. Evaluation of test answer sheets and preparing the test result report of class.
3. Preparing and maintaining reports for the whole class based on parameters decided for assessment of the learning levels of the students with their weightage.
4. Preparing a separate list of slow and advanced learners.
5. Preparing schedule for extra session/problem-solving session/revision session for slow learners.
6. Conducting the sessions for slow learners as per the prepared schedule.
7. Maintaining the attendance of slow learner sessions.
8. Preparing the list of advanced assignments of the list to tasks assigned to advanced learners.
9. Maintain all records for slow learners and advanced learners' activity

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Policy on slow learners and advance learners :

INTRODUCTION : A classroom has a bunch of students who have different level of perception, understanding and grasping ability. Few students can comprehend a topic at a faster pace, while a few may be slower. Therefore, it becomes paramount to determine the abilities of a student. Based on the capability of a student, few students may require a little guidance while the other group need attentiveness as well as specific supervision and management.

ASSESSMENT OF THE LEARNING LEVELS OF THE STUDENTS:

- **The concept of advanced learners:** The term "Advanced learners" refer to the students who understand a taught topic at a rate that exceeds that of their peers in one or more content areas. Their oral proficiency and writing skills is usually indistinguishable and exemplary from that of other students. They need acceleration so that they can progress through the curriculum at their learning pace, which is significantly faster than those at their grade level. These students are more hard working.
- **The concept of slow learner:** The "Slow Learner" mostly lag in their academic part and find it complicated to comprehend and grasp. They often require a lot of time and efforts to understand and memorizing topics. Their oral as well as writing skills are very diminished than those at their grade level. The poor performance may not be a sign of poor capacity or talent but may be due to inappropriate teaching methods, socio-economic background, lack of motivation and support, disorganized learning practices or even due to lack of understanding in multiple commands at one time.

↓ OBJECTIVES :

- ✓ To encourage the advanced learners to be excellent achievers.

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
↓ **PROCESS INPUT : Identifying criteria for slow performers and advance learners-**

- Undergraduate students securing below 50% marks in the first internal examination are categorized as slow performers whereas students securing more than 60% as advance learners.
- Post graduate students according to their grades in 6 monthly progress report are categorized into slow performers (C grades) and advance learners (A grade)


- ✓ The process to identify slow learners and advanced learners would be conducted after the declaration of the terminal exam result or after one month of teaching in the academic session.

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Methodology and criteria for the assessment of learning levels

- ✓ The internal examination is conducted by the faculty and the answer papers are assessed. After evaluation for the following protocol is followed.
- ✓ **Criteria for slow performer and advance learners:** students securing below 40% marks in the first internal examinations are categorized as slow performers whereas students securing more than 60% marks as advance learners.
- ✓ **Remedial measures for slow performers:**
 - Formal :**
 1. These students are followed at the department level by faculty member.
 2. The remedial classes are conducted regularly in addition to regular classes for performers by displaying time table and taking attendance.
 3. Their performances are evaluated by conducted internal examinations periodically
 4. Mentorship: Mentors are assigned to all students in batches of 10-15. Slow performers receive special attention from mentors and subject experts through close interactions. Regular interactive sessions, lab and hands on skill sessions are taken to overcome difficulties in a continuous manner.
 - ✓ **Outcome measures:** the outcome of slow performers in class tests, internal examinations, preliminary examinations and summative assessments are analyzed to ascertain/co-relate their consistency and improvement.

Consolidated report on special programs for advanced learner and slow learners

Slow learner are identified through the formative assessment in class test & clinical work . this include periodic assessment of performance in internal exam , laboratories and clinic at rotation under teacher / supervisor for task assignment submitted by the student.

Following majors taken by department for slow learners

Department offers remedial classes for the slow learners after internal examination by scheduling separate session Additional guidance in the form of assignments are provided to the student to improve the understanding and performance of the student.

Summarization of the topic before starting and at the end of the lecture is regular practice by faculty members.

The Department provide course wise mentor to each student for monitoring the academic and personal progress. Mentors organise meeting on monthly basis to monitor the progress of the students, to resolve /guide for academic of personal issues Mentors and coordinators regularly


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review academic progress and counsel students to improve performance and ensure academic growth.

Students are encouraged to participate in seminars/workshops to gain knowledge.

ADVANCE LEARNER-

Following strategies are used for advanced learners -

Students are encouraged to participate in various academic activities like quiz, poster competition, inter college competitions & various physiotherapy Camps.

Students are provided an opportunity to involve in research project under the guidance of experts, which help them to explore the various aspects involved in conducting research project. .

Students are motivated by mentor and guide to apply for patent, copyright, designs & exercise protocol related to patient case.

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- **Consolidated report of slow and advanced learner**

within the classrooms, faculty members have to deal with different types of student . Generally on the basis of their learning speed students can be classified into advance learners and slow learners. each type of student has different learning attitude and learning habits. A faculty has to adapt a teaching methodology as per type of learner

! We have prepared SOP for identification of slow and advance learners, modification of teaching methods and outcome monitoring. We have offered special programs for slow & advanced learners.

Programs offered to all students are

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Policy for Slow Learner or Fast Learner

2021-2022

On the basis of their preceding exam performance, current subject performance and class observation, learning speed students can be classified in two group:

- Advance Learner
- Slow Learner

Each type of students has different learning attitudes and learning habits. A faculty has to adapt a teaching methodology such that he/she may not lose the attention of the **slowlearners** and turn off the **advanced learners**. Based on the ability determined, some students need only guidance and some students need a hard work and regular attention.

The purpose of assessment of the learning levels of the students and conduction of activities for them is

- Identification of the slow learners and advanced learners in the class.
- To ensure that slow learners and advanced learners are taken care as per their needs.
- To help them out for improvement in their academics. And be equal to all students

The remainder of this manual describes the constituent parts of the slow learner and advanced learner identification process and activates for them and includes guidance on process.

Process Input:

To start identification of slow and advanced learner process following inputs is needed


- Preceding examination overall result
- Class test result
- Class observation by subject teachers

Process of Slow learners and Advanced Learners (Identification and Activities):

The process of assessment of the learning levels of the students and conduction of activities for them should be carried out through a systematic procedure as shown in the flow chart and explained in detail as below:


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Fig. 01 Process of Slow Learner and Advanced Lerner

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1. Assessment of the learning levels of the students:

- Slow learner and advanced learners would be identified for each subject separately by respective subject teacher for all the semesters.
- Process to identify of slow learners and advanced learners would be conducted immediately after declaration of preceding semester university exam result or after one month of teaching in case of (SEM I).
- Every subject teacher should conduct class test / online objective type test of their subject on syllabus covered till date or on first unit of 20 marks and duration of one hour to identify slow learners and advanced learners
- Slow and advanced learners are identified based on following parameters and their weightage.

S.NO	Parameter	Weightage in Percentage
1	Marks obtained by student in objective type test /class test / unit test conducted for respective subject	50%
2	Academic performance of students in preceding university examination	25%
3	Subject teacher observation	25%

- For parameter no. 03 every subject teacher should assess each student on scale of 1 to 10.
- Based on above parameter a report would be prepared for whole class for total 100%.
- The student securing marks below 40% would be identified as Slow Learners and the student securing marks above 70 % would be identified as Advanced Learners.
- After that separate list are prepared for both type of learners for further monitoring and conduction of problem solving sessions /revision sessions for them.

2. Conduction of activities for Slow learners:

- Provisions should be made in weekly time table by adding extra one hour to conduct problem solving sessions /revision sessions/extra sessions
- Make up classes and practical sessions should be conducted for Direct Second Year (DSE) Students to complete the syllabus within time.
- Personal Attention should be provided by respective subject teacher in teaching
- Assignments and solving University question papers
- Question bank
- Counselling – special hints and techniques.



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3. Conduction of activities for Advanced learners:

- Advanced assignments or tasks should be assigned to advanced learners.
- Encouragement to complete Advanced courses.
- Encouragement Participation in Seminars/Conferences.
- Assignment based on Model making/building.
- Industrial visits and industry sponsored internships.
- Platform should be provided through MoU's with various reputed Industries/ Research institute for the advanced learners to explore their talents.

4. Preparation of Performance improvement report of slow learner:

Each faculty should prepare report after university result declaration of current semester which shows the improvement in performance of slow learners to close the loop.

- Roles and Responsibilities of Subject Teacher:
- Subject Teacher is responsible for carrying out different aspects of slow learner and advanced learner identification.
- activities to be conducted Subject Teachers will be responsible for:
 - Conducting class test on unit 1 of 20 marks and duration of one hour.
 - Evaluation of class test answer sheets and preparing the class test result report of class
 - Preparing and maintaining report for whole class based on parameter decided for assessment of the learning levels of the students with their weightage.
 - Preparing separate list of slow and advanced learners.
 - Preparing schedule for extra sessions /problem solving sessions / revision sessions for slow learners.
 - Conducting the sessions for slow learners as per prepared schedule.
 - Maintaining the attendance of slow learners sessions.
 - Preparing the list of advanced assignment or list of tasks assigned to advanced learners.
 - Preparing the report after university result declaration of current semester which shows the improvement in performance of slow learners to close the loop.
 - Maintain the all records for slow learners and advanced learners activity.




